Background

- OCSE presentation for Directors at NCCSD 2018 Annual Meeting Closed Door Session:
 - Sample analysis of caseload, arrears and performance data in an easy to understand format
 - Commissioner’s Vision - expand OCSE reporting to assist the IV-D Directors
 - Use more visual analysis
 - Identify trends
 - Highlight outliers in an informational way
 - Compare data across systems
- Directors agreed and requested that OCSE move forward
 - Cynthia Longest, previously Indiana IV-D Director and currently Senior Technical Advisor to OCSE, was tasked with leading the effort
 - Calling the project “Data Analysis/Reporting for IV-D Directors”
 - For NCCSD, reports to the NCCSD Systems/Data Analysis Workgroup

Goals of Project

- Provide big picture view of data points in comparison with other states
- Reports should give actionable information as much as possible
- Reports should be “at a glance”, but provide ability to do comparisons
 - Compare to specific states
 - Compare to national averages
 - Deeper dive than readily available data
 - Include both OCSE “Administrative” Data (i.e. federal reports) and DFS data (e.g. tax offset)
- Report tool should be easy to use and intuitive
- Reports should be only accessible to:
 - IV-D Directors and designees
 - OCSE regional staff so they may provide assistance to Directors
- Try to meet the needs of those states that have the least time, resources and expertise

Examples of Data Sources Available for Analysis

- Annual Report data from OCSE 157, 34 & 396
- Federal Offset (FO)
- Federal Case Registry (FCR)
- National Directory of New Hire (NDNH)
- Multistate Financial Institution Data Match (MSFIDM)
- SSA garnishments data
- Insurance match
- Electronic Income Withholding Orders (E-IWO)

Tools

- Reports themselves:
 - Tableau Desktop for report development (OCSE)
 - Tableau Reader for accessing more functionality of the reports (States and OCSE Regions) <https://www.tableau.com/products/reader>
 - Exported views of reports (PDF, PowerPoint, Word, etc.) – research in progress
- Accessing the reports: Alfresco site at OCSE under construction

Pilot Workgroup

- Assembled pilot workgroup of state and regional representatives.
 - Five state and four regional representatives
- Pilot workgroup tasks:
 - “Test drive” the tools
 - Give feedback on reports themselves
 - “Test drive” mechanism to access the reports, once available
 - Assist with ideas for new reports
- Group meets periodically, approximately once a month

Status

- Pilot group(s) have met five times. Next call January 29.
- All reports must undergo a separate QA process before release.
- Directors notified via NCCSD Listserv in December 2019
 - Decide who besides themselves to use the reports

 - Dates of first webinars (same content for each)
- Three reports substantially complete: Undistributed Collections (UDC) Parts 1-3:
 - UDC Part 1 -- Overall UDC: subject of the January 17/21 NCCSD webinars
 - UDC Part 2 – UDC by Age: ready
 - UDC Part 3 – UDC by Category: -- in QA review
- Working on best mechanism for export of specific slides
- Alfresco implementation pending

 - Support Order Establishment Deeper Dive
 - Expenditures
