

Explore the Columbia River Gorge

At Skamania Lodge

Fitness & Recreation	Fitness center, indoor pool, outdoor hot tub, and the Gorge Loop Fitness Trail
Golf	Two golf experiences: Gorge 9 , a 9-hole walking course suitable for all skills levels (book a tee time) or Little Eagle 18 , a 19-hole putting course (no tee time required) Disc Golf and Fling Golf are also available
Skamania Adventures	Outdoor recreation including bike rentals, zip lines, aerial obstacle courses and axe throwing
Spa treatments and wellness services	Massage, skincare, and wellness services available by appointment

Stevenson, Washington (1-2 miles from Skamania Lodge)

Downtown Stevenson	Walkable district featuring shops, restaurants and Columbia River views
Stevenson Waterfront	Paved pathways and public gathering spaces along the Columbia River with views of the Gorge

Within 10 miles of the Lodge

Beacon Rock State Park	State Park centered around a prominent basalt monolith with hiking trails and panoramic river views. <i>Note: a Discover Pass is required to Washington State Parks for day-use. The park is equipped with an automated pay station for visitors to purchase a one-day pass or purchase online.</i>
Bonneville Dam Visitor Center	Educational facility features salmon programs and several large white sturgeon. Open seasonally from 1-4 PM
Bonneville Fish Hatchery & Sturgeon Center	Home to one of the region's largest fish hatcheries and several historic white sturgeon
Bridge of the Gods	Historic toll bridge (\$3) connecting Washington and Oregon across the Columbia River, and forms part of the Pacific Crest Trail
Sternwheeler Columbia Gorge	Sightseeing and dining cruises offering views of the Columbia River from a historic-style paddlewheel vessel

20+ miles from the Lodge

Cape Horn Overlook	Scenic viewpoint overlooking the Columbia River Gorge with minimal walking required
Columbia Gorge Waterfalls	Explore waterfalls through the Gorge via scenic drives, short walks and hiking trails.
Hood River	Charming, small-town on the Gorge with downtown shops, boutique restaurants and breweries, and a hub for windsurfing, kiteboarding and rafting.
Multnomah Falls	Oregon's tallest waterfall and one of the most recognizable landmarks in the Pacific Northwest book a timed permit if arriving by private vehicle
